Daily Morning Bell Work Time 8:20-8:40 a.m.





Indoor Recess Time- 20 min. as weather dictates


Friday Reward Time- 2:15 – 2:55 p.m.


Class List will be put at each computer for students to initial when time is completed.


The next person on the list will be told that they are “up next” freetime.
